**RESULTS:**    *The Court tentatively **GRANTS IN PART** and **DENIES IN PART** Defendants' motion to dismiss and **RESERVES** ruling on Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction.*

Plaintiff and Defendant shall add additional parties by no later than 10 days after the Defendants file their responsive pleadings to the operative complaint.
