21 Plaintiff files this notice to inform the Court that a Uniform Domain Name Dispute
22 Resolution Policy (UDRP) proceeding for the transfer of decoderpro.com has commenced.

23 Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN), the organization
24 responsible for global coordination of domain names, adopted the UDRP in 1999 for resolving
25 disputes over domain names through an administrative proceeding conducted by a resolution
26 service provider. Under the standard Terms and Conditions clause in domain name registration
27 agreements, the registrant must submit to the proceeding. Several organizations act as resolution

service providers.

In Defendants' Second Motion to Dismiss [Docket 100], Defendants sought to dismiss Plaintiff's cybersquatting claim for failure to join Jerry Britton, the registrant of decoderpro.com, who they believe is a necessary party and over whom they assert the Court does not have personal jurisdiction. (As the Court is aware, Plaintiff contests this, and in the alternative, offered at the Jan. 19, 2007 hearing to remove from the Prayer for Relief the transfer of decoderpro.com to Plaintiff.)

Plaintiff recently filed a Complaint with a resolution service provider, seeking the transfer of decoderpro.com to himself. Per UDRP rules, Plaintiff has served UDRP Complaints on all parties required to be served. If the resolution service provider orders the transfer, then Defendants' Rule 12(b)(7) motion to dismiss is moot. Plaintiff will inform the Court when the resolution service provider issues a ruling.
